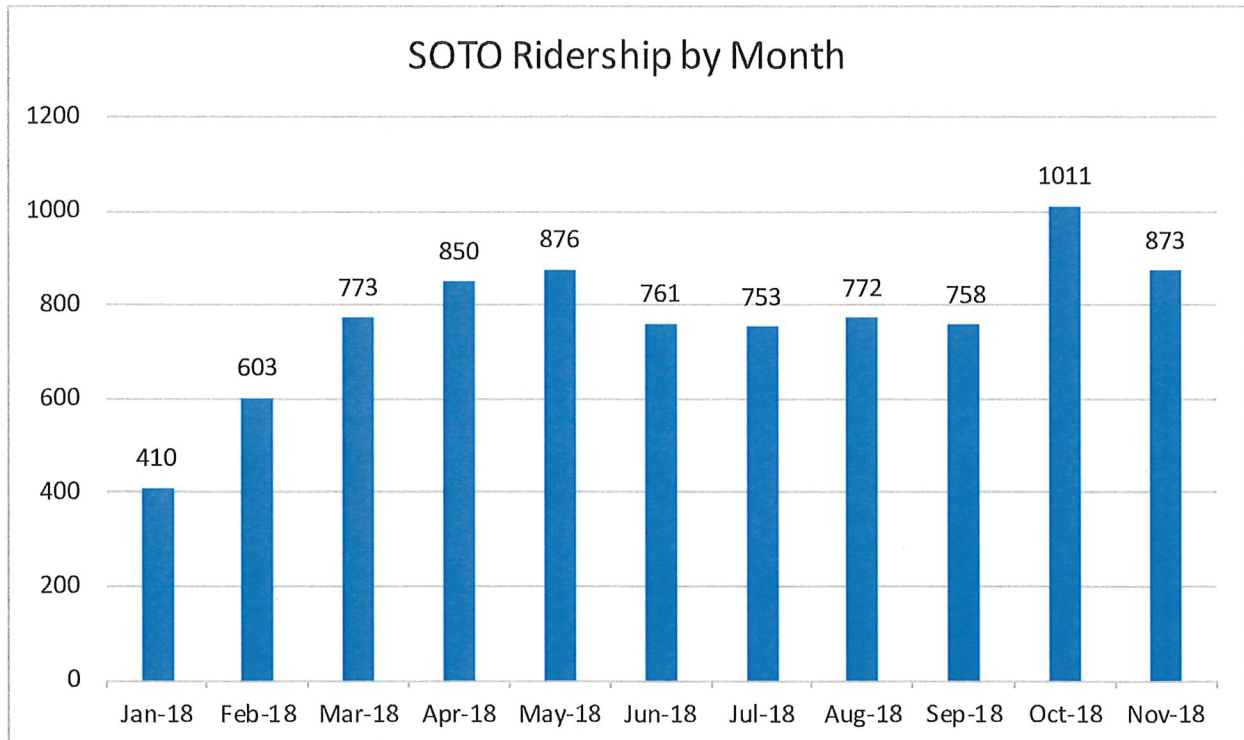

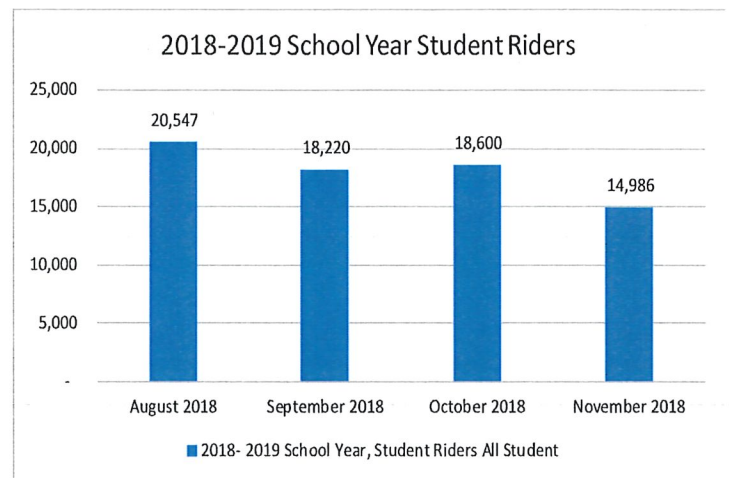
Ridership Table Notes

- Line 13: Flex rides had a second strong month with 77 rides, the second highest monthly total ever (79 in November 2016), nearly twice the average of 40 monthly rides in the last 12 months.
- Line 17: Other Non-revenue includes promos for Vets Ride Free, Shop 'Til You Drop, and Election Day free rides.
- Lines 21-22: The number of Ambulatory Lift rides remains low. The November total of 82 is 50% below the 12 month average of 167 and 230 rides lower than November of 2017.-

- Shop 'Til You Drop- The Saturday after Thanksgiving ridership was 2,408, a 10% increase over the same day in 2017.
