



Reduced Fare ID Card Application Form

For persons age 65 and older

The holder of a Topeka Transit Reduced Fare ID Card is entitled to pay a reduced fare (using cash, coupons or monthly pass) for fixed route bus service. This card does not entitle the holder to Lift services.

Reduced Fare ID Card MUST be shown to the driver when boarding the bus.

Eligibility

The Reduced Fare Program is designed for

1. Persons with disabilities,
2. Medicare recipients,
3. Persons age 65 and older
4. Persons age 5 through 18

To apply for a reduced fare ID card

1. Applicant must complete the Reduced Fare ID Card Application Form on back.
2. Verification of age is required. Documents accepted for this are: driver's license, Kansas ID, or birth certificate. If the document provided is not a photo ID, a second form of ID with a photo will also be required.
3. When completed, bring form and above documents to: Topeka Transit – Quincy Street Station, 820 SE Quincy, Topeka, KS 66612.
4. Topeka Transit will process Reduced Fare ID applications upon receiving the properly completed form and ID. When an application is brought to Quincy Street Station, it will be processed while you wait.

Cost

There is no cost for the initial card. A \$5 fee will be charged for any replacement cards.

Card replacement

1. Report lost or stolen cards immediately to Topeka Transit by calling 783-7000
2. To receive a Replacement Reduced Fare ID Card, the cardholder must fill out a Replacement Application form available at the Quincy Street Station or by calling 783-7000 to receive one by mail.
3. Submit your Replacement Application and \$5.00. The request will be processed and a replacement card will be issued. You may be asked to come into Quincy Street Station to have a new picture taken.

Guidelines

Topeka Transit reserves the right to determine qualifications for special fare programs. A Reduced Fare ID Card will not be issued if the applicant fails to provide Topeka Transit with properly completed application form, certification of proof of age, or correct payment for replacement cards. A Reduced Fare ID Card is not to be loaned or borrowed. Topeka Transit reserves the right to confiscate a Reduced Fare ID Card which has been used improperly. A fee of \$30 will be charged for the replacement of confiscated cards.
